

Naval Science Class Enrollment Summary

UC Davis

UC Davis students should only sign up for the Naval Science class itself, not the laboratory. UC Davis students receive letter grades for the class only.

- Scholarship students: Complete the simultaneous enrollment form from the link below by the deadline on the form.

- College Program students: You do not need to fill out the simultaneous enrollment form. Instead, simply audit the class.

Note: Semester units are converted to quarter units by multiplying the semester units by 1.5.

Naval Science 1 and Naval Science 2 - Unit Distribution:

- Fall: 3 Semester units = 4.5 Quarter Units
- Winter: 1 Semester units = 1.5 Quarter Units
- Spring: 1 Semester units = 1.5 Quarter Units

All other Naval Science Classes - Unit Distribution:

- Fall: 3 Semester units = 4.5 Quarter Units
- Winter: 1.5 Semester units = 2 Quarter Units
- Spring: 1.5 Semester units = 2.5 Quarter Units

UC Berkeley

- Scholarship students: Enroll through *Telebears* as usual with your assigned Course Entry Code (CEC).
- College Program students: Either enroll through *Telebears* with your CEC or audit the class.

UC Berkeley students receive a letter grade for all Naval Science classes and receive unit credit for laboratories.

California Maritime Academy

Naval Science grades do not appear on CMA transcripts.

Stanford

Stanford Students receive a Pass/Fail grade for all Naval Science classes. The Leader Development laboratory counts as 1 unit and the Naval Science class counts as 2 units per quarter. Spring Naval Science classes count for both Winter and Spring Quarters.
